

Blackboard Collaborate Cheat Sheet for Students

Get Started

- Use **Google Chrome**[™] with your collaborate room for the best experience.
- Point to the avatar image and select *My Settings* to set your profile picture.
- Also from Your Avatar > My Settings, set up your audio and video and adjust your volume. You
 must give the browser permission to use audio and video.

Use the Tools

- Participants panel: View the list of participants. Click Open Participants List.
- **Hand raise**: Raise your hand to answer a question or get another moderator's attention. Click *Raise Hand*. If you use your keyboard to navigate, press Alt + H.
- **Status:** Show yourself as away. Point to your avatar to open *My Settings*. Select *Set as Away* from the *Present* drop-down list.
- **Zoom**: Resize shared content. Double-click on the content to make it bigger.
- **Picture-in-picture:** Change the focus of your screen. If shared content is on your main screen, switch to watching the speaker. Click the picture-in-picture to bring that content to your main screen.
- **Grid view and Speaker view**: Switch between viewing multiple participants in your centre screen and viewing the active speaker only.

The following tools can be turned on or off by the Instructor

- Chat: Chat with participants. Click Open Chat.
- Audio and video: Click Share Audio and Share Video to turn those tools on or off. If you use your keyboard to navigate, press Alt + M to turn your microphone on and off. Press Alt + C for your camera.
- Annotation: Type, draw, and edit shared content.
