



## Expressions of Interest for appointment to Edith Cowan University Committees and Boards

Edith Cowan University's governance arrangements include a number of committees and boards which include external community members. In order to enhance the pool of potential members of these committees and boards, the Nominations Committee of Council would like to invite Expressions of Interest from community members willing to contribute to the governance of the University.

Council is keen to ensure that the membership of its committees and boards reflects the skills and experience required to oversee the advancement of the University whilst reflecting the diversity which a complex and contemporary organisation needs. Expressions of Interest are sought from individuals with skills and experience relevant to the governance of a multi-million dollar enterprise, and with a desire to help shape the direction of the University and thus play a direct role in developing professionals and leaders for the future.

Members of Council or its committees and boards are not remunerated.

As most members serve multiple terms, only one or two vacancies may arise each year. There are often specific skills required. Those submitting Expressions of Interest are asked to understand that it may not be possible to obtain a position in the short-term.

ECU has a rich culture and strong sense of inclusion and particularly welcome applications from people culturally and linguistically diverse backgrounds, people with disabilities, Indigenous people, women, young people.

An Expression of Interest should include a current resume and a short (one page) outline as to why you are attracted to a role on ECU's Committees or Boards.
