Edith Cowan University has over 17,000 students and some 1,700 staff. It offers undergraduate and postgraduate degrees from three metropolitan campuses and the Bunbury Campus which is 200 kilometres south of Perth.

The University is the second largest in Western Australia, educating about 30 percent of the state's university students. In the 1993 academic year 3,823 students completed course requirements for graduation.

More than 200 study programmes are offered through six faculties: Arts, Business, Education, Health and Human Sciences, Science and Technology and the WA Academy of Performing Arts. International enrolments exceed 800 students from 42 countries. An intensive English Language Centre operates from the Claremont Campus.

Edith Cowan University has strong links with remote communities in Western Australia through its contracted courses to regional centres, Aboriginal education centres and external studies. Numerous training and research links also exist with industry.
