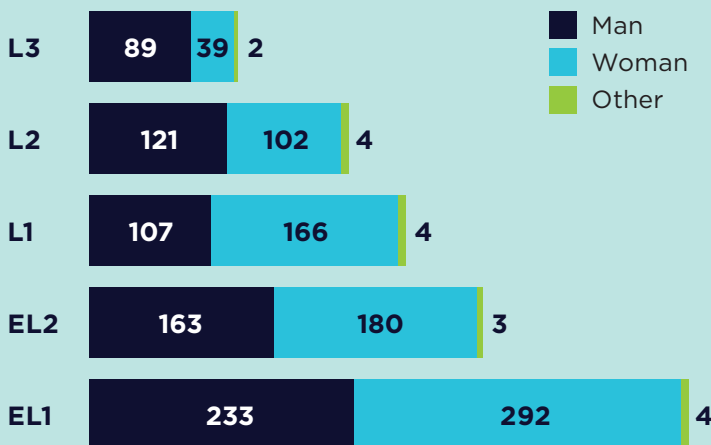

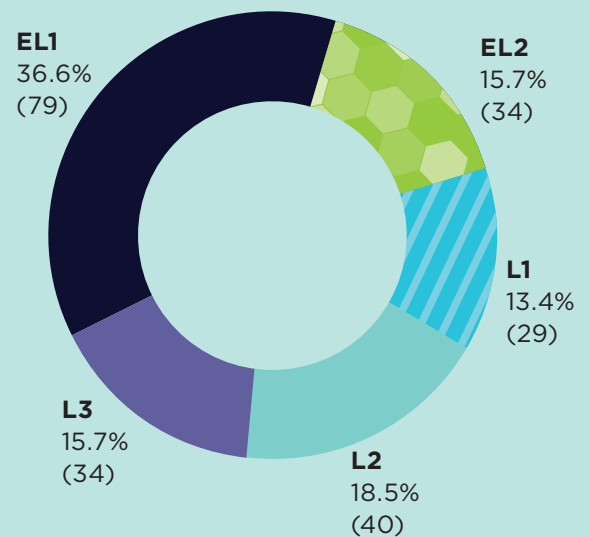

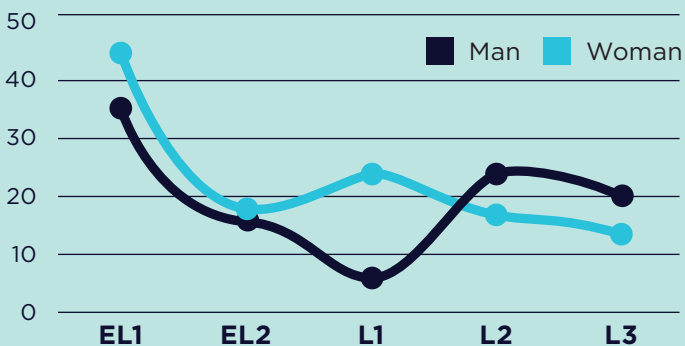

FUNDED APPLICATIONS BY GENDER*



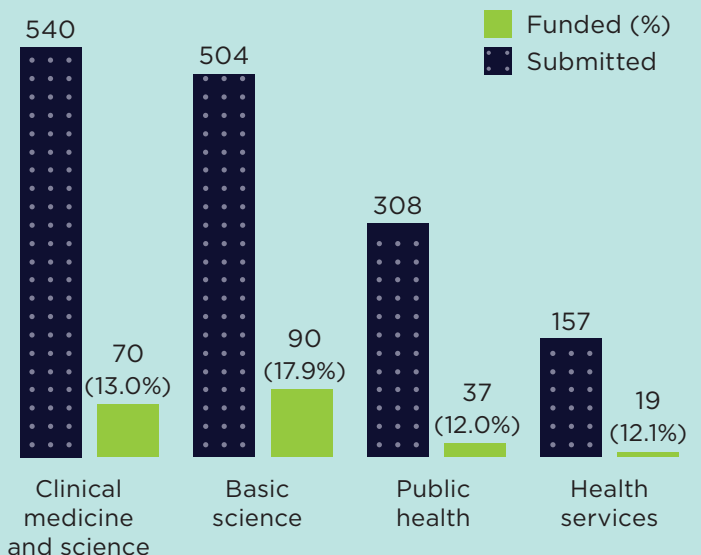

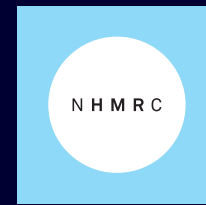
GRANTS AWARDED BY BROAD RESEARCH AREA

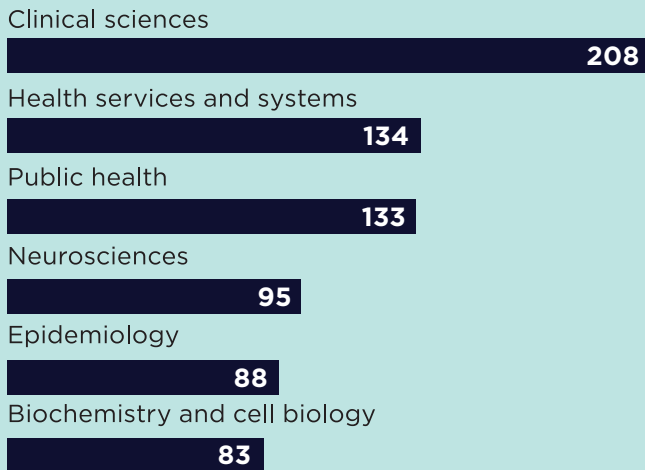

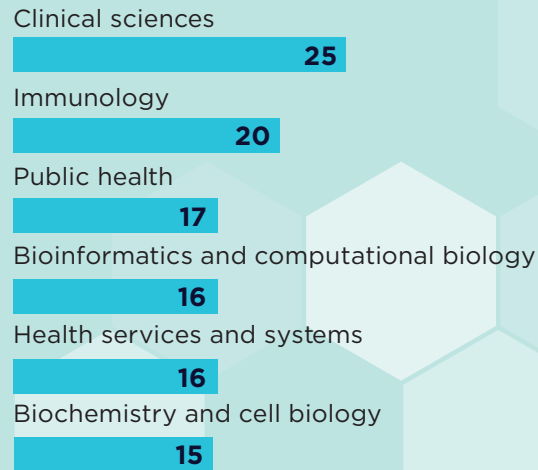

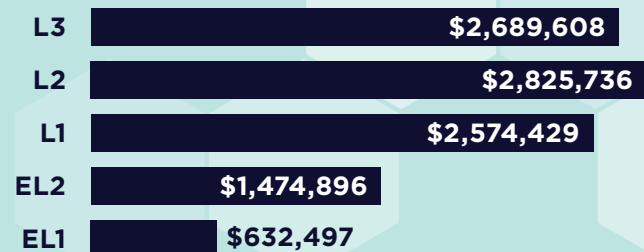

YEARS POST PHD EXPERIENCE

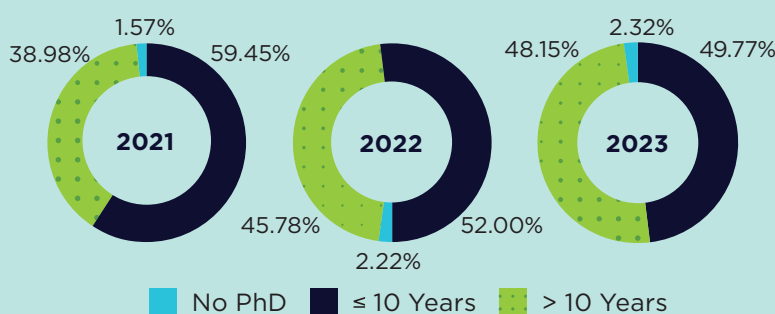
Percentage of new Emerging Leadership Fellows who have 4 years or less post-PhD (or equivalent) experience.
