- Applications for Alternative Exit are to be submitted either once you have enrolled in your final unit(s) of the exit award or following completion of the required units.
- Students with Credit and Recognition for Prior Learning (CRPL) must consult the <u>Maximum Credit Table</u> to ensure you do not exceed the maximum credit applicable within the exit award.
- There are two exit pathways: "Intermediate Award" and "Exit Award" and you must consult: What is an alternative exit and how do <u>lapply?</u> prior to completing this form.
