What is LastPass?

Like most people, you're probably struggling with nearly 200 passwords at work and at home. That's too many! You may also be reusing passwords so they're easier to remember, but that leaves you vulnerable to security breaches. LastPass is here to help.

LastPass is a secure password manager. All your usernames and passwords are stored in one safe place called a vault. After you save a password to the vault, LastPass will remember it for you. When you need to log in to a website, LastPass enters your username and password for you.

A password manager can also help you:

- Create new passwords
- Rate your password security
- Store information such as PIN codes and membership IDs
- Share passwords securely with others
- Fill out addresses and credit card forms

Why should I use LastPass?

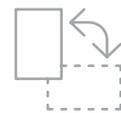
LastPass will help you improve your efficiency as you move through your day-to-day work, while helping to improve the overall security of the company.

LastPass remembers every password, logs you in to websites and seamlessly generates new passwords.

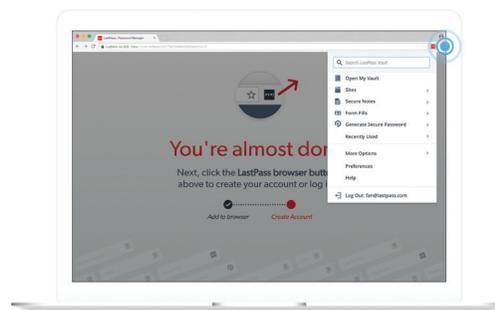
Getting started with LastPass

Once your admin invites you to join LastPass, you'll create your master password. The same username and password unlocks your LastPass account on any device.

1. Get to know the LastPass extension

LastPass installs on your browser toolbar.

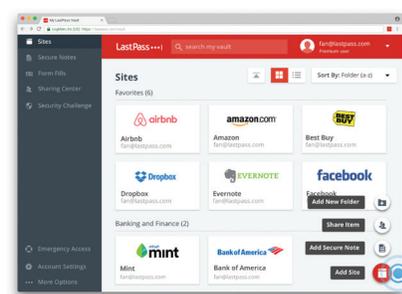
- Quickly save, autofill and generate passwords.
- Red means you're logged in; gray means you're signed out.
- Click the extension to see menu options.
- Download the extension for the fastest browsing experience.



2. The vault is your command central

Everything you store in LastPass can be managed from your vault.

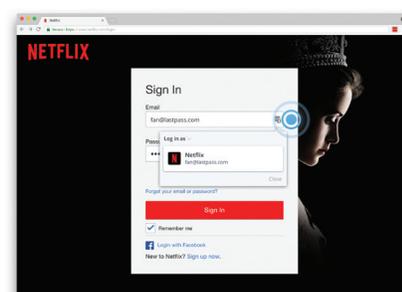
- View, edit, share and delete passwords.
