

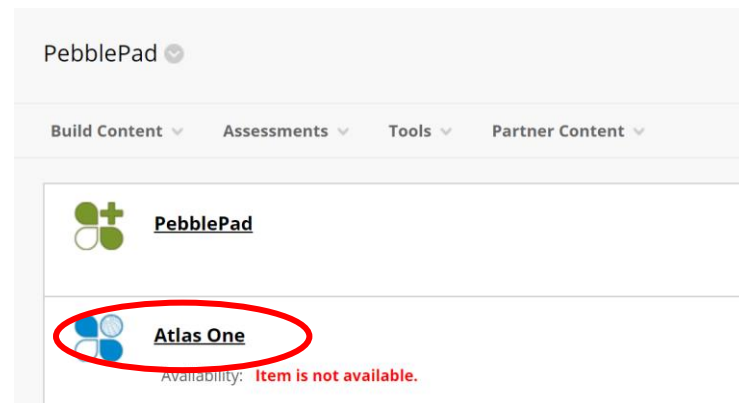
# Marking with Turnitin in PebblePad....

This tip-sheet describes the process of marking using Turnitin with a PebblePad assignment. This assumes that the ATLAS Workspace, assignment, Turnitin link, and any Turnitin rubric have already been created; that the Turnitin rubric has been attached to the assignment; and that the student submissions have been submitted to Turnitin from within PebblePad. Please contact your unit coordinator if any submissions have not been submitted to Turnitin. After submitting to Turnitin student submissions can be viewed and marked through Turnitin Feedback Studio using the Turnitin commenting tools and a Turnitin rubric if required. Each student submission is accessed in Turnitin from the Turnitin icon on the Submissions page.

## Access Workspace

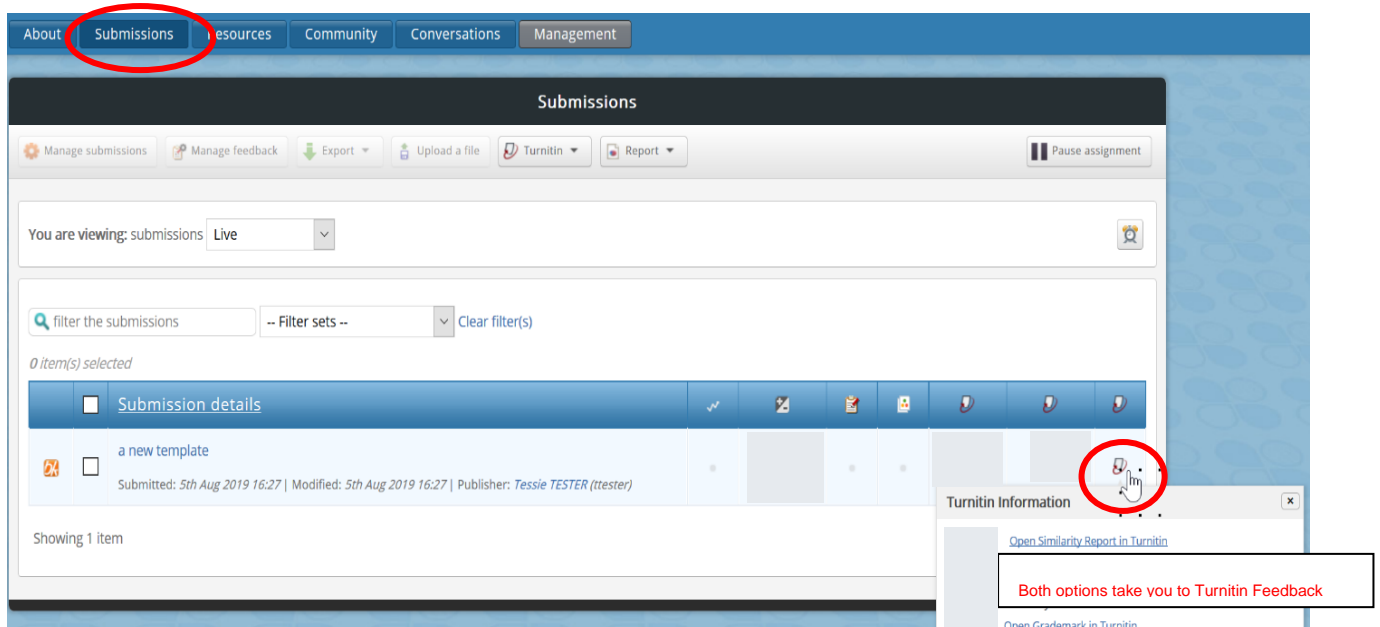
The link to the ATLAS Workspace can usually be found via the PebblePad/eLearning Portfolio item in the unit menu.

Clicking on the ATLAS link will take you to the unit's Workspace. You might see all the tabs (About, Submissions, Resources, Community, Conversations, Management) or only some of them (e.g. Submissions, Resources, Management).



## Submissions tab

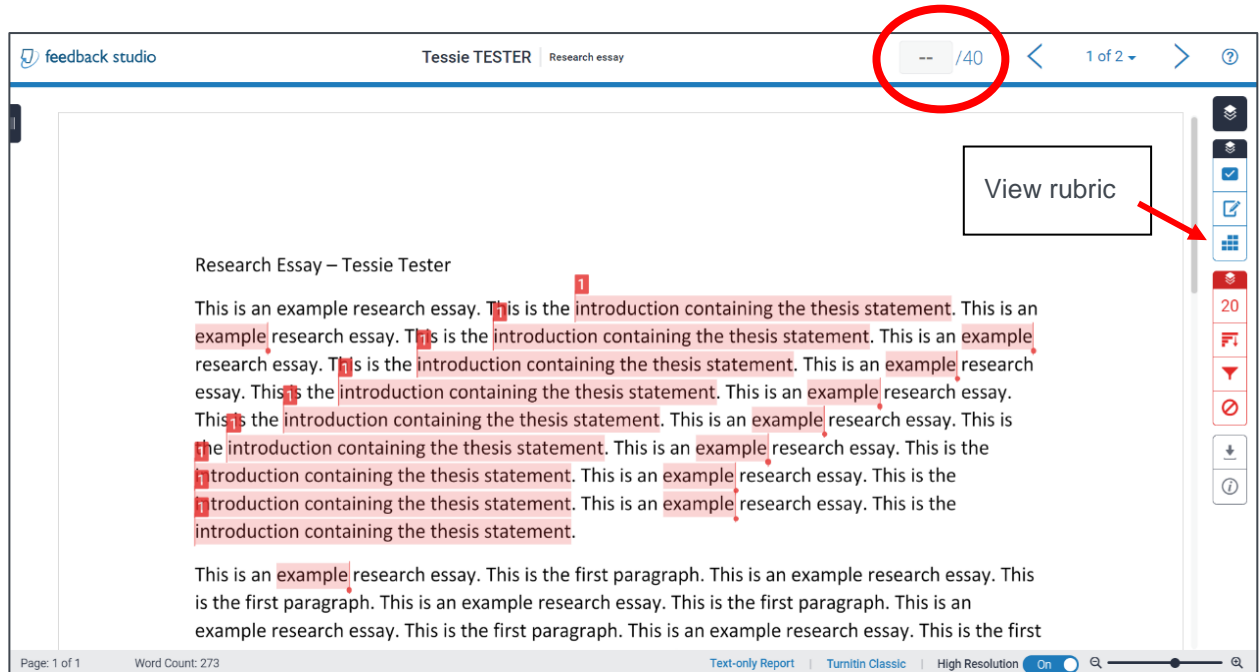
Click on the Submissions tab to find all the student submissions.



Click on **Open Similarity Report in Turnitin** or **Open Grademark in Turnitin** – either will take you to Feedback Studio.

## Marking and commenting in Feedback Studio

In Feedback Studio, you can use **commenting tools** to add feedback for your students. You can type the grade for this submission at the top of the screen. Please note that Turnitin only accepts whole numbers – no decimals.

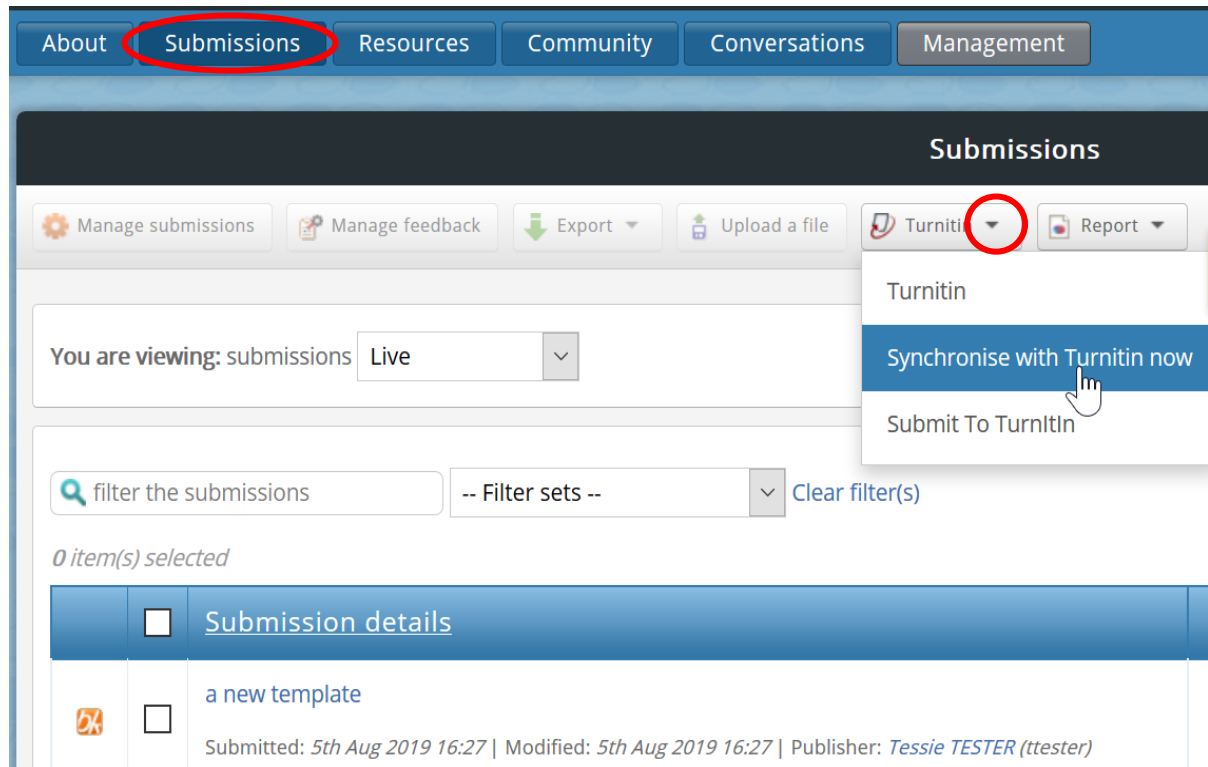


You can also mark using a rubric if one has been attached. **If you see that a rubric is attached to an assignment, do not remove the rubric after marking has started or you will lose all your marking.**

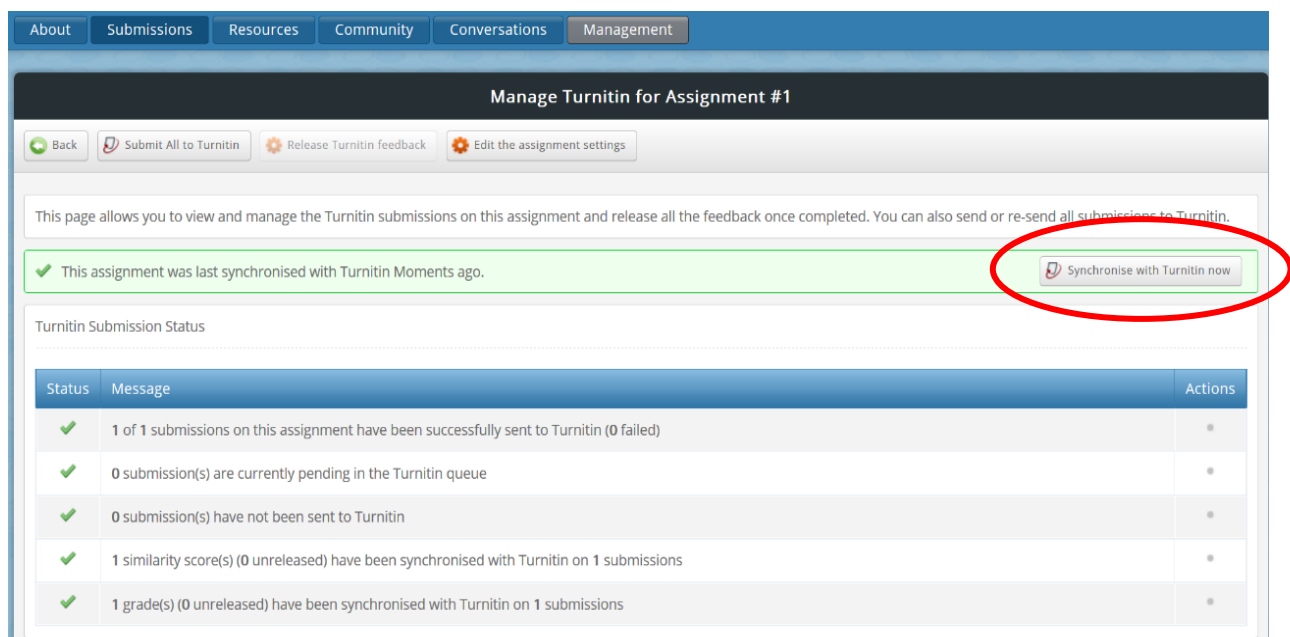

## Synchronise the Turnitin marks with ATLAS

When you have finished marking the student submissions in Turnitin the next step is to synchronise the marking in Turnitin with ATLAS. From the Submissions page in ATLAS, click on **Synchronise with Turnitin now** from the Turnitin dropdown.



You can also Synchronise with Turnitin from the Turnitin information page.



Synchronising allows the Turnitin similarity score and the Turnitin grade to be displayed in additional columns against each student submission in ATLAS. Please allow some time for this to complete.

You can check the Turnitin information page for the status of submissions. Please note: student submissions will be automatically synchronised once an hour if you remain on the Submissions page.
