EXAMINATIONS IN THE SPORTS HALL BUILDING 22 – JOONDALUP CAMPUS

Arrival and Venue Information

Many of the examinations at Joondalup Campus will be conducted in the Sports Hall located in Building 22. The venue details within your personalised student timetable in SIMO will be shown as JO 22.113/114/115.

It is recommended that you arrive at Building 22 <u>at least 30 minutes before the scheduled exam time</u>. However, please note that you are not permitted to enter the building until instructed to do so by the Invigilator.

The Sports Hall will be air-conditioned; however, it is advised to dress appropriately for the season/temperature.

Allocated Seating

The Sports Hall has assigned seating. If your exam is scheduled in this venue, take note of your allocated seat number as indicated in your personalised timetable on SIMO.

Signage placed at the front of Building 22 will direct you to the correct assembly area for your seat number. You are responsible for gathering in the designated assembly area and must follow the directions provided by the Invigilators.

When your seat number block is called, please queue quickly and quietly in a single line at the entry as directed.

Entering the Venue

Once directed to enter the venue, refrain from communicating with other students, and maintain examination conditions.

Listen carefully to all instructions and avoid crowding the entry area; stand back until called.

Ensure you have your student ID, a valid Australian photo driver's licence, or passport ready to show the invigilator before entry.

Security Measures

Some examination venues are under closed-circuit television (CCTV) surveillance. Footage from CCTV may be reviewed and used for university purposes.
