

You might like to create a rubric in Excel and then import it to your Turnitin rubric library. Only gualitative rubrics can be made in Excel, but the type can be changed to add scoring after it is imported.

Create an Excel file

Create an Excel file containing your rubric using the following rules:

- a. The file must be .xls or .xlsx
- b. Only one rubric per Excel file
- c. The rubric must have the scales as the first row up to 20 scale item colum
 d. The rubric must have the criteria as the first column up to 50 criteria rows The rubric must have the scales as the first row - up to 20 scale item columns
- e. Criteria descriptions should be in the same cells as the criteria titles and separated by a line break
- f. Criteria titles must be 13 characters or fewer
- g. Scale titles must be 25 characters or fewer
- h. You can change the rubric type after it is imported from qualitative to custom or standard scoring

Shown below is an example of the rubric in Excel. An Excel 'template' of a rubric can be obtained from the import function in Turnitin (see below).

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Import the Excel file

After creating your rubric in Excel, the next step is to import the rubric to your Turnitin rubric library.

Turnitin rubrics are imported through Turnitin's 'Rubric/Form Manager'. This can be launched when the assignment is created or edited.

Rubric/Form Manager can also be launched through Turnitin Assignments under Blackboard Unit Tools (choose Libraries then Rubric/Form Manager) or through a student submission in Feedback Studio. Please be aware that there are some slight differences when Rubric/Form Manager is launched through Feedback Studio – the rubric can be uploaded (the equivalent to imported).

Launch Rubric/Form Manager through an assignment

- One of the 'Optional settings' when you create or edit a Turnitin assignment is Online grading.
- Click on Launch Rubric/Form Manager.

- A default rubric will open.
- Choose Import from the icon on the right-hand side.

You will see:

- a. A summary of the file requirements and the example template download link.
- b. Select your rubric Excel file to import.
- c. Or drag and drop to import.
- d. The rubric will be saved in your Turnitin rubric library, and an import complete message will appear.
- e. Clicking View will display the new rubric and you will be able to edit as necessary.
