Smart phones are mobile computers, not just phones.



Your smart phone likely has access to your email, Facebook, and may contain other sensitive details. It's very important that you protect and secure your phone as you would your home or University computer.

Here's how:

1. Set a pin on your phone and set it to lock automatically.
2. Back up your phone data regularly.
3. Don't download content or applications from unknown or unreliable sources.
4. Always install the latest updates.
5. Do not open multimedia messages (MMS) or attachments from people you don't know.
6. Turn off additional services when you aren't using them such as Bluetooth, GPS and WiFi.
