
A summary of all the hazards already identified by your School or Centre. Developed in consultation with the Local WHS Committee and approved by the Executive Dean/Director.

<u>Health and Safety Hazard Risk Assessments</u> Required wherever hazards may be present. Examples include:

- o To resolve a specific identified hazard
- When a Health and Safety issue is raised
- When commencing or changing an activity including:
 - ✓ Teaching activities (e.g. per Unit)
 - ✓ Research activities including clinical trials and grant applications
 - ✓ Purchasing new plant or equipment
 - ✓ Travel activities (e.g. study tours, fieldwork)
 - ✓ Events (e.g. Open day)
 - ✓ New projects (e.g. infrastructure)
