After a formal change management process, ECU has decided to outsource the bookshop function to The Co-op Bookshop.

The University is taking this step because of rapid changes in the book retail and publishing sectors and the need to ensure that its students are provided with educational resources at competitive prices.

The ECU Shops at Joondalup and Mt Lawley campuses will close their doors on Friday 30 November 2012. This is to allow staff to do stock checks and work with The Co-op staff on a smooth transition. The shops will re-open for business on Monday 7 January 2013 under The Co-op. Web orders for 2012 will be accepted up until 30 November.
