

# Quick Guide

## Panopto Embed Video in a Blackboard Content Area

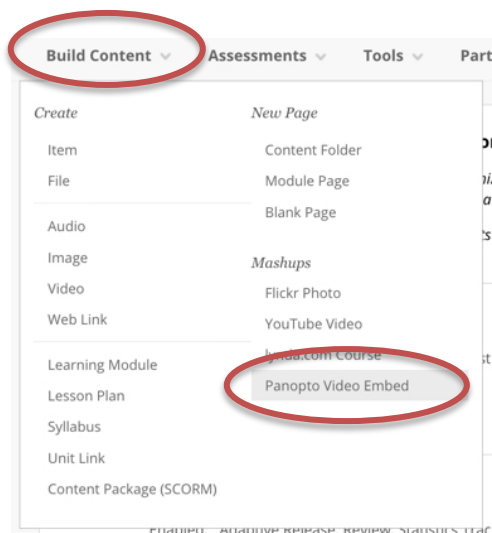
Two options are available to embed a Panopto video in a Blackboard content area:

1. **Panopto Video Embed** from the Content Area > Build Content tool.
2. Text Editor **Mashups** tool.

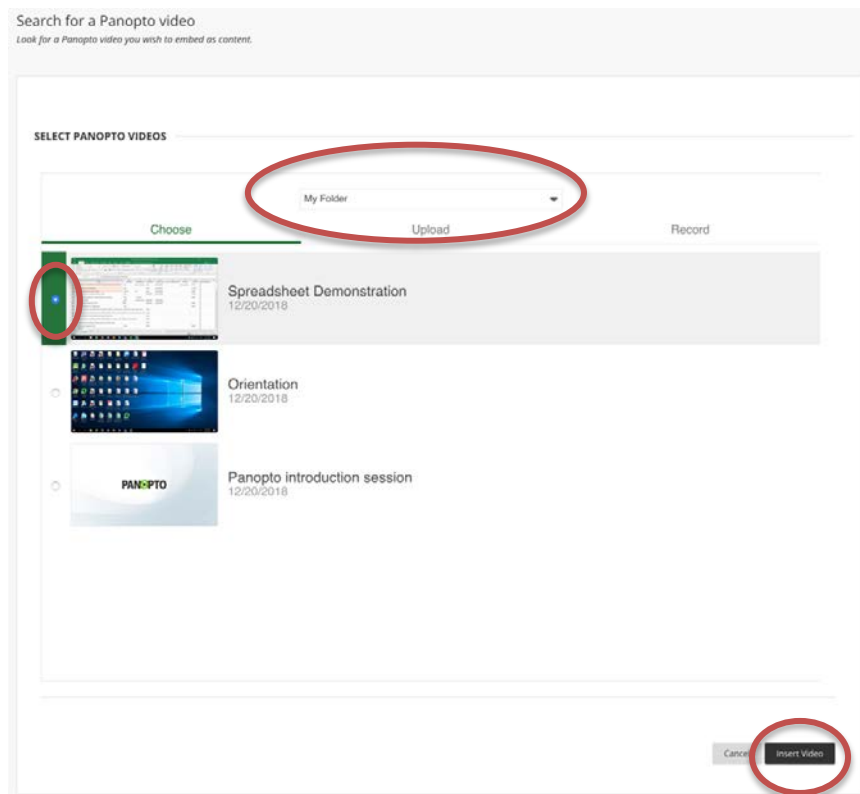
### 1. Panopto Video Embed

This is the easiest method to insert a video in a Content Area. With this method there is no option to add a description or ability to resize the video.

- 1.1. In a Content Area, select Build Content > Panopto Video Embed.



- 1.2. Select the folder containing the required video.
- 1.3. Select the video and click on the **Insert Video** button.

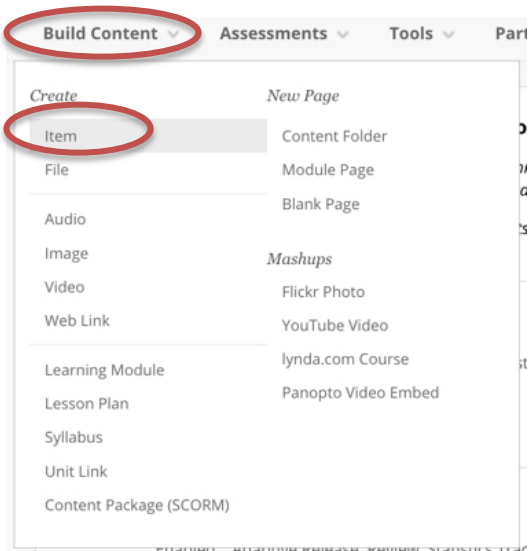


- 1.4. The inserted video will appear at the end of the content page. Reposition the video to associate with the existing learning content.

## 2. Text Editor Mashups Tool


This method provides greater flexibility in that you can add a text description and adjust the video size to any tool with a text editor e.g. Item (in the following example), Assessment or Discussion Board.

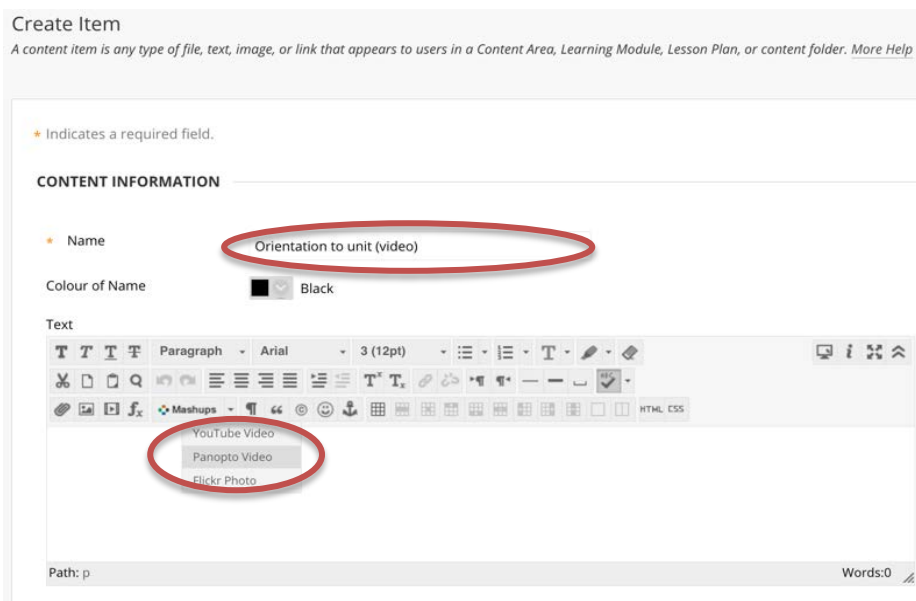
2.1. In a Content Area, select **Build Content > Item**.



2.2 Provide a title of the video in the Name field.

2.3 Provide a description in the Text box.

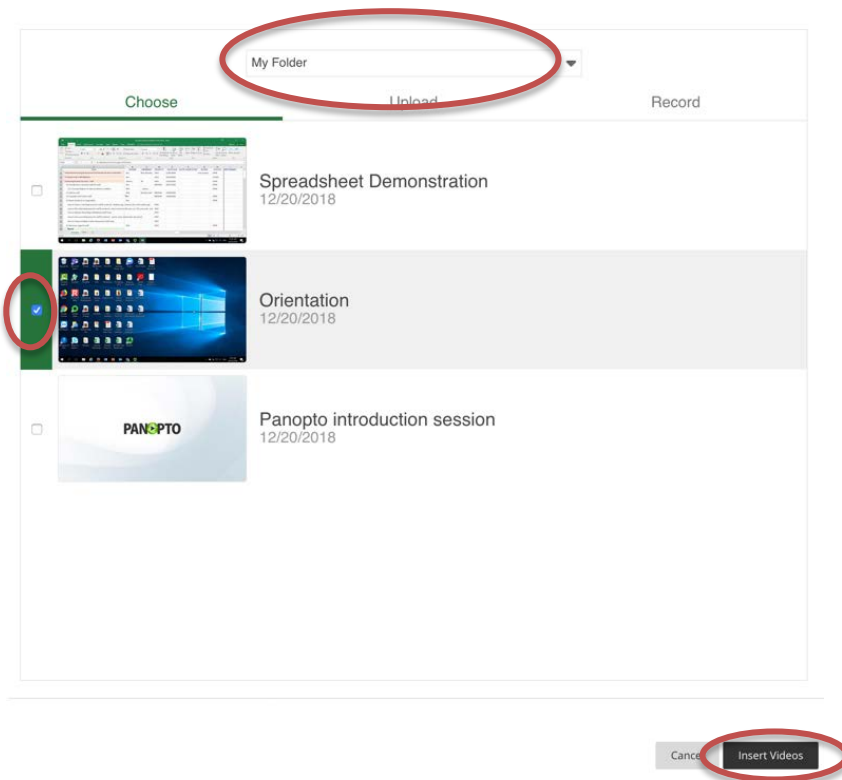
2.4 Select **Mashups > Panopto Video**. (Note: if you can only see one toolbar in the text editor, click the Show More  icon).



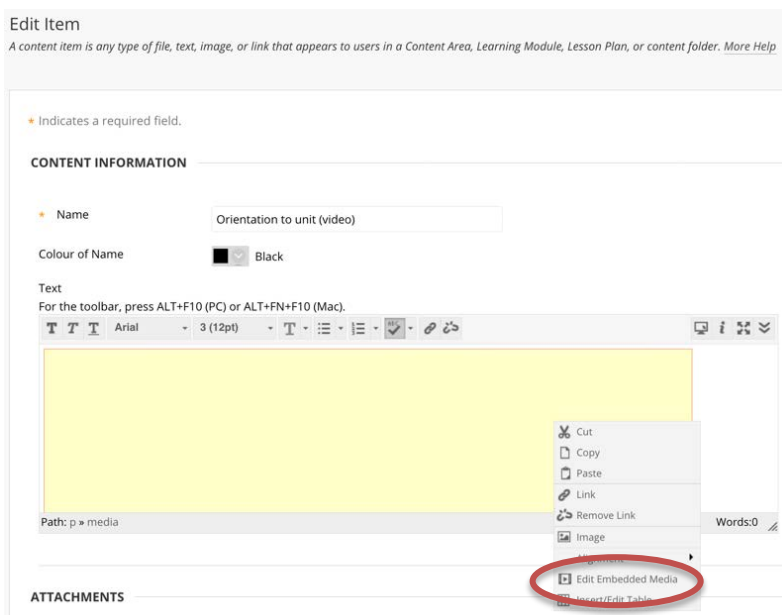
2.5. Select the folder containing the required video.

2.6. Select the desired video and click on the **Insert Video** button.

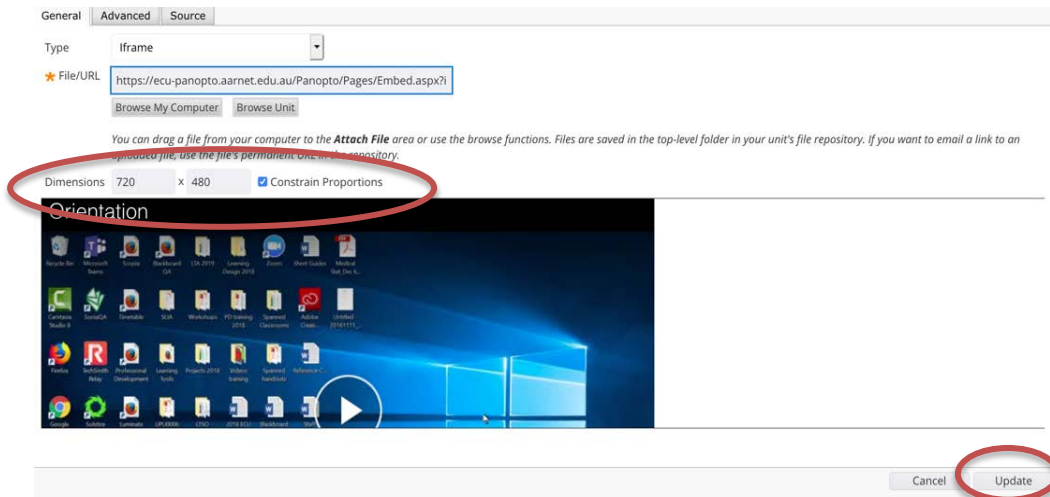
2.7 The Edit Item page will display a yellow box as a placeholder for the video.



2.8 Optionally you can resize the video in this screen. Right mouse click on the yellow box and select **Edit Embedded Media**.

2.9 Select a suitable pixel dimension for the desired video size. With Constrain Proportions selected, you will only need to change one dimension.

Note: An alternative method to resize the image is by dragging the image handles of the yellow box (single mouse click on the box will reveal the handles), however this may give an inconsistent result in a page containing multiple videos.



2.10 Click the **Update** button.

2.11 Complete the remaining options in the Edit Item page and select **Submit**.
